Many are Searching

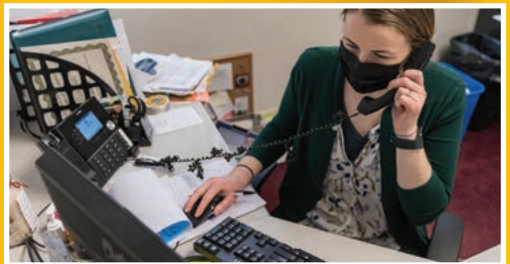
